1. President's report

I have had the pleasure of being President of RC Prague International, an experience that will stay with me forever.

The year was dedicated to environmental issues by the RC President, who wanted every member from the 1.2 million membership to plant a tree. I felt that in the Czech Republic we had enough trees, therefore planting in Zambia was a better idea. We partnered with WeForest a charity that works with locals to move from burning wood for charcoal to planting trees for fruit. They also encourage the making of honey by having hanging bee hives in the trees, a great source of income for the local community.

We were involved in the Fairy Tale Fesitival in Annaberg Bucholz. Our Club sponsored a trip for children from a Prague orphanage, providing them with a bus, food and tickets to the festival. The children were treated like VIPs and were about to meet Princesses and Princes from the world of Fairtales. Our RCPI member Philip Albrecht was very involved in the organising of the festival.

We held our third Sananim Gala event, raising 250,000 kc for the charity that works with addicts and their families and have a fantastic 80% success rate.

We arranged to sell burgers at Burgerfest, this event is a fund-raiser for the dog shelter, it also gives the club members a chance to work together over the two days of the event. It also gives the club the opportunity to show the community what Rotary is and what we do.

There was a trip to Cesky Krumlov with our 'twin' club, RC Bristol Breakfast Club. The Bristol club arrived at Bristol airport for their flight, to find it was cancelled. This did not stop RCPI, we enjoyed a weekend of hiking and around the area and fun evenings getting to know each other better.

We had six new members this year, it is great to see the membership grow and I am delighted with the caliber of candidates that are coming forward.

Indian Food Helps – the project to raise funds for schools in India by selling Indian lunches for two weeks throughout Prague, was a bigger success than last year as the project becomes more widely known throughout the Prague business community. This year we raised 3,500 Euros, this will enable schools in Rajasmund district to by equipment, uniforms, blankets and other essential school items for the students.

We had one Youth Exchange member from USA, our young member initially struggled with life in the Czech Republic but grew to love his time here and was sad to leave having told us that he had learned much about himself on this journey.

We had a very successful Dragon Boats with 27 teams entering the event, the highest number of boats in the ten years the club have been organising the race. It is thanks to the hardwork of Vlasta that this took place, she worked very hard to complete this big fundraising event. We raised 250,000 kc for a number of local Czech charities.

My personal highlights were the 20th anniversary of our club held in April at the Aristocratic waiting rooms at the main station. We had members from the past, founding members and our District Governor helping us celebrate the successes of RCPI over the last 20 years. A very special moment to be President of this club.

We have had a spectacular list of speakers, many Ambassadors have given us their time, scientists doing amazing work in the Czech Republic, people from the Arts and Cultural scene of Prague. We had actors, painters, designers and curators come and speak of their work, all very interesting in their own way.

This is just a small selection of the many events and activities undertaken by Rotary Club Prague International in 2017

January 2017 – Netherlands Ambassador Visits



Ambassador Ed Hoeks of the Netherlands joined Rotarians, visitors and friends at our recent club meetings. Following club proceedings and dinner he presented Brexit in the broader context of events both contemporary and historical. Drawing a link between the French revolution, the Russian Revolution and the rise of nationalism, he proposed that we are exiting a period of libertarianism and are entering uncertain times as nations focus inwards and on themselves rather than having themes of cooperation.

March 2017: Canine Rescue



Members of Rotary Club Prague International, along with Zdeněk Střžek, owner of <u>Bejzment Burger Pub</u> and also the promoter of the Jack Daniel's BurgerFest in Prague, visited Psí útulek Trója to deliver many large bags of quality dog food and a pet carrier. This donation came from the proceeds of RCPI's participation in BurgerFest 2016.

Psí útulek Trója is the city-owned dog shelter for

Prague, and cares for 120 or more dogs at any moment, with sometimes more than 200 dogs coming through the facility in a single month. In 2016, the shelter cared for more than 2,000 dogs, and the Prague animal protection service reached the milestone of having processed the adoption of 80,000 animals (dogs, cats and others) since it opened in 1993.

March 2017: RCPI receives Membership Development Award

May 2016 Rotary Dragon Boat Charity Challenge

27 teams entered the Rotary Charity Dragon Boat Challenge and competed in the name of charity on the Valtava river in Prague. The teams were made up from clubs, societies, organisations and companies from the Prague region including Rotary clubs. Good natured rivalry and a determination to win spurred on the paddlers whose competence and confidence increased with each heat. However it was not all about winning - the event raised substantial sums for the three charities which were selected as the beneficiaries from the 2017 event: ŽIVOT 90, an organisation providing a wide range of services for senior citizens, Nadace Naše Dítě who offer much needed help and support for many children in very difficult circumstances and Výbor dobré vůle (VDV) whose main purpose is to help disabled, abandoned and discriminated against people to integrate into society. A big THANK YOU has to also go to Peter Klima and the Czech Dragon Boat Association for their kind help and assistance without which this event would not be possible.

June 2017 – The end of the Rotary Year



As the Rotary year draws to a close, RCPI president Sanan Phutrakul addressed the members at our recent meeting. "It has been an outstanding year" commented Sanan, reflecting on the many achievements of the club. RCPI raised over CZK 1.2m for charity through a wide range of events which culminated in the annual Dragon Boat Charity Challenge which raised over CZK 500,000 on one day.

Many new members have joined the club and we have bid some farewell as they have moved away. We have enjoyed social events as well as many occasions where we have come together to raise funds including selling mulled wine, Burger fest, members for members parties and of course the Sananim Gala Dinner.

Our aim is to be awarded a <u>Rotary Presidential Citation</u> for the great work we have done throughout the year." Sanan presented the goals and targets which the club has to meet by the end of June 2017 in order to achieve a citation. "We are on track in many respects and just need a little bit of a push in some areas where we are just short of achieving the goal." Helen Noll will take on the role of RCPI President for the Rotary Year 2017/18.

June 2017 – Another Prize for RCPI



MD. Ilja Chocholouš, Deputy District Govenor of district 2240 presented Sanan Phutrakul, President of Rotary Club Prague International, with the Significant Achievement Award for the contribution to Rotary in the year 2016/16. RCPI has grown as a club, raised thousands for charity and led the way in transforming the club into an organisation where like minded people come together to do good whilst

having fun. The President's citation is a recognition of the very significant achievements in different aspects of Rotary.

August 2017 – A fairytale



That was the feeling of 16 children from the Zatek orphanage who enjoyed a day out at the <u>Internationales Märchenfilm-Festival "fabulix"</u> in Annaberg-Bucholtz thanks to Rotary Club Prague International.

Rotarians Filip Albrecht and Sanan Phutrakul organised the visit which turned out to be 'the best trip ever' as described by the children on their return.

Filip's inspiration founded the festival and he organised many special surprises for the children which started with a Czech viewing of "Korunni Princ" in the main square. They met a real life Princess and Prince (Alexandra and Georg zur Lippe) in a private reception and the Mayor, Rolf Schmidt, who presented the children each with a bag full of gifts to remember the day by.

October 2017 - Indian Food Helps!



Our annual event to raise funds to help poor rural schools in Rajasthan, India was more successful than ever in 2017.

With fantastic support from our Rotarian Mamun Saiz of The Curry House Prague, members collected orders and delivered a record number of Indian lunches to hungry customers in many organisations around the city. Thanks to the funds raised from this event and additional donations

from Rotarians and others, we raised more than CZK 120,000 to support one large primary school in Rajsamand.

November 2017 – Sananim Gala – another record

At a recent meeting of RCPI, Nelly and Naomi presented <u>Sananim</u> with a cheque for CZK 257,000 (€10,000). The donation was as a result of the Gala Dinner which Naomi and Nelly organised for the charity and represents a record, topping even the very successful 2016 Gala. Jiri Richter, Pepa Sedivy and Agáta Jankovská received the donation and thanked RCPI for the donation which

will make a real difference to the lives of those being rehabilitated. Jiri commented that such a donation is particularly welcome in the uncertain times when state funding is continually being reviewed.

Founded in 1990, SANANIM is one of the largest non-governmental organizations in the Czech Republic that provides complex services in the area of prevention, treatment and resocialization of non-alcoholic drug addictions.

5. Youth Service

RCPI has an active youth service programme within the framework of Rotary International's New Generation focus. Rotary District 2240, The Czech Republic and Slovakia, is particularly active in the youth exchange programme and RCPI is a strong supporter of that programme. **WHAT IS A ROTARY YOUTH EXCHANGE?**

Rotary has been organising youth exchanges for over 60 years, providing incredible opportunities for young people to see the world, experience a different way of



life, maybe learn another language, make international friends and discover a lot about themselves whilst acting as an ambassador for their own country.

Parents and guardians can be assured that Rotary is committed to maintaining a safe environment through policies designed to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all participants in the programmes.

Each year, worldwide, over 8000 young people enjoy the experience of a lifetime through Rotary Youth Exchange and for many this is an amazing voyage of self discovery which changes their lives forever.

Our club hosted three students, two girls and one boy. One of the girls is from India and the second is from Italy while the boy comes from Thailand. We have also three Czech students that are out in the world being hosted by Rotarians.

The students in the whole district 2240 (Czech and Slovak) just finished a two week Euro trip together and are slowly preparing for the return to their home countries. Its a tough time for the students, with separation of close friendships that they have made with the other students and the host families. But the good thing is that many of these friendships are for life so most of them will keep in touch and meet again.

We sent one Czech girl to Canada for the 2017/18 school year and we will be hosting one boy from US.

We also have a family exchange student, a girl that will be leaving for Taiwan first part of the summer and spend the second part of the summer by hosting a Taiwanese girl here in Czech Republic.

RCPI has a very active student exchange programme which gives young people from our region the chance to live in another country as well as students sponsored by other clubs to experience life in the Czech Republic.
